BACK TO THE COURTROOM

"Your Honor, "may I approach the bench?"

The Judge nods in answer to the Prosecutor's request. The defense attorney rises to file behind him.

"Your Honor, I don't think the witness qualifies as the Almighty God," the prosecutor complains. The Judge looks to the witness and with a hand held up tells Him to keep His seat. "If he were God, he would be more like the God we all learned about in Sunday School. He fits none of the criteria; He has, essentially, none of the characteristics of 'God.' I request to voir dire the witness."

The Judge massages his chin, scratches his head, and gazes off into the air between him and the ceiling. "Your request is granted, but with a proviso. There are problems."

"What proviso? What problems? Your Honor?"

"If YOU perform the voir dire, and subsequently this court determines the suitability of this witness, we will, effectively, be PRESUMING to know who God is and what characteristic He should have. The witness will have to be judged accordingly. First, we must agree upon an authority. The decision cannot be up to persons having no firsthand knowledge of the criteria that would decisively determine that he IS or IS NOT the God Almighty. He may not be who YOU think God should be. He may not be who the jurors think God should be. but who God is is still in the area of uninformed conjecture and deduction on the part of all parties involved. Today, you/we are attempting to know, prove, and legally determine the person and identity of a God who, at least up until now, has chosen to remain unknown to mankind. It will be very difficult to authorize a benchmark."

Attorney for the Defense, I.M. Jason, longtime colleague of the Judge, now interrupts, "Judge.... May I offer a suggestion?"

"Of course." Judge mutters, cleaning his glasses and seeing only through unfocussed eyes.

Counselor Jason continues, "For centuries, indeed for millennia, the Bible is probably the most widely respected authority in religious circles. Jew and Gentile alike have grown up with it and consider it to be an indisputable authority."

"No, no, NO!" Bob Weaver protests. "The question of the Bible as an authority invariably becomes a parallel argument of, interpretation (Blah, blah, blah...)."

"Granted, the Bible and the people of the Bible have suffered for centuries due to maligned

interpretations and translations, "Jason submitted, "but, can we agree upon what it actually says – apart from a rigid, fundamentalist, or stubborn slant, neither a figurative, spiritual or romantic technique. Can we not take a pragmatic, thoughtful and semantic approach?"

"This will be difficult to maintain!" replies Judge. "Impossible!" retorts the prosecutor.

Judge continued, "This court will proceed giving the Bible the evaluation of the credibility of this witness. "Now," Judge rubs his hands together as if awaiting the deal in a card game, "which version of the Bible shall we use?"

Bob Weaver explodes, "Here we go! You see? This is exactly what I was trying to avoid!"

Jason, in his usual calm and sure demeanor interrupts, "Your Honor, I will concede to use any version or translation of the Bible that the prosecutor wishes. The subject matter is so basic, undoubtedly the version will be inconsequential."

"Thank you, Counselor." Judge turns to the Prosecutor, "Surely, you cannot contest this proposal."

We need to answer, not because He requires an answer, but because of our own need to analyze the process we use to come to a conclusion. Our warped concepts of God cause warped conclusions. Our warped conclusions will not be even recognized because, no matter how warped they are, they make perfect sense to us! They make sense to us


TIME IS THE ALLY OF DECEIT

because of the very fact that the conclusions are formulated in our own minds and because of the information we have collected (or merely manufactured) for ourselves.

"And the husbandmen took his servants, and beat one, and killed another, and stoned another. Again, he sent other servants more than the first: and they did unto them likewise. But last of all he sent unto them his son, saying, They will reverence my son. But when the husbandmen saw the son, they said among themselves, This is the heir; come, let us kill him, and let us seize on his inheritance. And they caught him, and cast him out of the vineyard, and slew him. When the lord therefore of the vineyard cometh, what will he do unto those husbandmen? They say unto him, He will miserably destroy those wicked men, and will let out his vinevard unto other husbandmen, which shall render him the fruits in their seasons." (Matthew 21:35-41)



Well, how about YOU? Can you speculate what the Lord of the Vineyard will do? Your answer, no matter how right or wrong, will make perfect sense to you; HOWEVER, will it be accurate according to the revealed characteristics, philosophy, and passions of the God of the Bible?

Some religions do not allow the God of the Universe to think and act as He wills. Many of the Religious hear Jesus' question, "What do you think the CEO will do when he gets back?" And, not being allowed (or willing) to answer outside their denominational frameworks, answer something along the lines of, "God loves us just like we are. We're not perfect, just forgiven. Sources and opinions are gathered apart from the Bible and are presented to make sense of what doesn't make a bit of sense when using the Bible alone. God's name, personality, character, no, not even His principles can be squeezed from the pages of the book Modern Christians worship. Most do not know (much less obey) the immutable Law He has given us. Yet, modern Christianity continues to grow. How can it be? How can it continue?

The God found in the minds of most Christians cannot endure the voir dire. So, in order to protect the God they have created in their own image, they do not subject Him to examination. The competency of the God of their own creation is never questioned.

The true and living God of the Bible – the God of Abraham, Isaac and Jacob CAN ENDURE the voir dire. He feels no




