However, it is not how man treats those he hates that exemplifies man's depravity – it is how he treats those he claims to *love*. It is not man's propensity to destroy his fellows that should gain our attention – it is his *incapability* to love them.

Jesus, fascinated with fallen man's ridiculous prejudices, truthfully answered the question, "Who is my neighbor?" by telling a story that exposed previously unnoticed bigotry. He wanted the man to learn that his bias to hate prevented him from loving even those who prove to be his benefactors. Such a nonsensical posture could never properly examined without coming face to face with our helpless depravity.

He stood beside the coffin and swore that he would never touch liquor again. Two hours later he was staggering drunk. Hopping a train, he landed in Chicago in January 1897 where he sold his shoes to buy another drink...

The depravity of man emerges as a mild embarrassment, then becomes a problem to society, and after attempting a cure and experiencing failure it is then ignored as *normal* and excused with *nobody's perfect* until it submerges in the syrupy, treacle of a *tolerant society*.

They tend to think that it is man's discomfort, lack, and necessity that lends to man's depravity.
