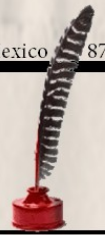

It is no wonder that Jesus spent so much time trying to tell us that the Kingdom of God is not like anything we have ever before experienced. Up is down. Down is up. Left is right and right is all that's left. Who we honor is only lightly esteemed. Who is despised and rejected today will come to the top like cream then.

I dislike the analogy of war as it is ubiquitously applied to the adversarial relationship of YHWH to His Archenemy. War is another one of those things that we cannot abide nor absorb apart from our fallen nature. War thrives and depends upon the sin in us. If we can see war without selfishness, if we are aware of insistent leadership without tyranny, if we demand righteousness without threats of inhumane punishment, then (and only then) are we approaching understanding the benevolent dictatorship we will all enjoy in the Kingdom of God. Furthermore, if we have this understanding, we can use terms like "Holy War," and then may we speak of *Righteous Indignation*, we may utter "Jihad," we may speak as the Oracles of God – but not until then!

War is the fallen substitute of our righteous Father leading a nation, governing a people, and demanding holy living from His children without legislating morality or continually killing until the world is "safe for democracy." Only our Father *can*. Only He *may*. Only He *will*!


Without ultimately trafficking in the last enemy of man, the answer to the prayer of two millennia of Christendom (my opinion) will be resolved - **at Pentecost!**

10. Thou shalt not covet thy neighbour's house, thou shalt not covet thy neighbour's wife, nor his manservant, nor his maidservant, nor his ox, nor his ass, nor any thing that is thy neighbour's.

Counting of the Omer

Counting of the Omer (**Hebrew**: ספירת העומר, **Sefirat HaOmer**, sometimes abbreviated as **Sefira** or **the Omer**) is a verbal counting of each of the forty-nine days between the **Jewish holidays** of **Passover** and **Shavuot** as stated in the **Hebrew Bible**: **Leviticus 23:15-16**.

This **mitzvah** ("commandment") derives from the **Torah** commandment to count forty-nine days beginning from the day on which the **Omer**, a sacrifice containing an **omer**-measure of **barley**, was offered in the **Temple in Jerusalem**, up until the day before an offering of wheat was brought to the Temple on Shavuot. The Counting of the **Omer** begins on the second day of **Passover** (the 16th of **Nisan**) for **Rabbinic Jews** (Orthodox, Conservative, Reform), and after the weekly **Shabbat** during **Passover** for **Karaite Jews**, and ends the day before the holiday of **Shavuot**, the 'fiftieth day.'

The idea of counting each day represents spiritual preparation and anticipation for the giving of the Torah^[1] which was given by God on **Mount Sinai** at the beginning of the **month** of **Sivan**, around the same time as the holiday of Shavuot. The **Sefer HaChinuch** (published anonymously in 13th century Spain) states that the Hebrew people were only freed from **Egypt** at Passover in order to receive the Torah at Sinai, an event which is now celebrated on Shavuot, and to fulfill its laws. Thus the Counting of the **Omer** demonstrates how much a Hebrew desires to accept the Torah in his own life.



Tradition *alone* is why some are counting omers instead of Days!

Act 2:1-47 “And when the day of Pentecost was fully come, they were all with one accord in one place. And suddenly there came a sound from heaven as of a rushing mighty wind, and it

filled all the house where they were sitting. And there appeared unto them cloven tongues like as of fire, and it sat upon each of them. And they were all filled with the Holy Ghost, and began to speak with other tongues, as the Spirit gave them utterance. And there were dwelling at Jerusalem Jews, devout men, out of every nation under heaven. Now when this was noised abroad, the multitude came together, and were confounded, because that every man heard them speak in his own language. And they were all amazed and marvelled, saying one to another, Behold, are not all these which speak Galilaeans? And how hear we every man in our own tongue, wherein we were born? Parthians, and Medes, and Elamites, and the dwellers in Mesopotamia, and in Judaea, and Cappadocia, in Pontus, and Asia, Phrygia, and Pamphylia, in Egypt, and in the parts of Libya about Cyrene, and strangers of Rome, Jews and proselytes, Cretes and Arabians, we do hear them speak in our tongues the wonderful works of God. And they were all amazed, and were in doubt, saying one to another, What meaneth this? Others mocking said, These men are full of new wine.

But Peter, standing up with the eleven, lifted up his voice, and said unto them, Ye men of Judaea, and all ye that dwell at Jerusalem, be this known unto you, and hearken to my words: For these are not drunken, as ye suppose, seeing it is but the third hour of the day. But this is that which was spoken by the prophet Joel; And it shall come to pass in the last days, saith God, I will pour out of my Spirit upon all flesh: and your sons and your daughters shall prophesy, and your

young men shall see visions, and your old men shall dream dreams: And on my servants and on my handmaidens I will pour out in those days of my Spirit; and they shall prophesy: And I will shew wonders in heaven above, and signs in the earth beneath; blood, and fire, and vapour of smoke: The sun shall be turned into darkness, and the moon into blood, before that great and notable day of the Lord come: And it shall come to pass, that whosoever shall call on the name of the Lord shall be saved. Ye men of Israel, hear these words; Jesus of Nazareth, a man approved of God among you by miracles and wonders and signs, which God did by him in the midst of you, as ye yourselves also know: Him, being delivered by the determinate counsel and foreknowledge of God, ye have taken, and by wicked hands have crucified and slain: Whom God hath raised up, having loosed the pains of death: because it was not possible that he should be holden of it. For David speaketh concerning him, I foresaw the Lord always before my face, for he is on my right hand, that I should not be moved: Therefore did my heart rejoice, and my tongue was glad; moreover also my flesh shall rest in hope: Because thou wilt not leave my soul in hell, neither wilt thou suffer thine Holy One to see corruption. Thou hast made known to me the ways of life; thou shalt

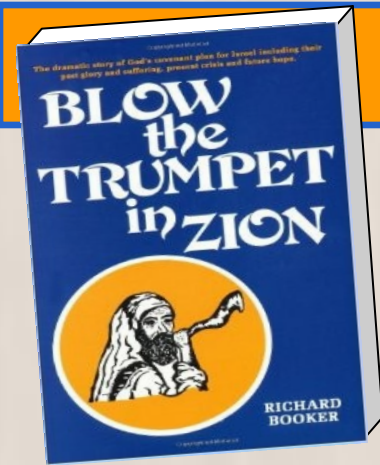

Blow the Trumpet in Zion is considered to be the most complete book available on Jewish history and end times prophecy of Israel. While I found this to be partly true, I encountered some contradictory statements made by Dr. Booker in addition to some comments that I simply could not agree with. Even so, I am recommending this book to all Th**INK**ers because I believe it will challenge your beliefs

concerning the state of Israel, the rebuilding of the Temple, end time events, the Millennial reign of Yeshua, and who the people of Israel truly are.

Blow the Trumpet in Zion focuses mainly on Moses' prophecy about the past, present, and future of the Jews. Dr. Booker breaks down this prophecy as follows: 1) The Jews will break the covenant Jehovah made with Abraham 2) He will then drive them from their land 3) God will scatter them among the nations 4) The Jews will be few in number among the nations 5) The Jews will serve other gods 6) Jehovah will preserve a remnant of the Jews until the latter days 7) He will bring the Jews back to their land 8) The Jews will go through tribulation 9) The Jews will return to God, and 10) Jehovah will remember His covenant.

Although the Old Testament history of the Jews was easy enough to agree with, I had problems as Dr. Booker was explaining the millennial reign of Christ. Booker writes, "*The prophet Ezekiel provides information concerning worship activities during the Messianic kingdom (Ezekiel 40-48). In these chapters, Ezekiel describes a religious system that includes a temple, priesthood and sacrifices. Although the Messiah will be the center of worship, He will use the religious system as a physical object lesson to show in a tangible way who He is and what He has done. The religious teachers will use these object lessons to point people who are born during the Millennium to the Messiah and their need for Him as personal Lord and Savior.*" (page 144) Just a few pages later, however, Dr. Booker is explaining that Yeshua came to fulfill the law. He states, "*Now that Jesus has come, there is no more need to bring animals to a building to be offered by a priest. He made the ultimate sacrifice for us when He gave His own life. When we come to Him as our Lord and Savior, we receive forgiveness of sin and inherit eternal life. God then writes His laws on the fleshy tablets of our hearts. We become the dwelling place of God by receiving the Holy Spirit. This enables all of us to minister as priests of God, and we give ourselves as a living sacrifice to Him (page 155).*" Unfortunately, both cannot be true. Either Jehovah still requires sacrifices, or His Son is living on the inside of us leading and guiding us into all truth!

One comment that I absolutely could not agree with is Dr. Booker's view on the Ten Commandments. In his chapter on ***Why Christians Should Love Jews***, he states, "*God never intended the Jews to approach Him by trying to keep the Ten Commandments. He knew they could never keep them. The Commandments were just a mirror for the people to see how holy God is and how sinful they were. So the Ten Commandments were not given for the purpose of saving the Jews. The Ten Commandments cannot offer the necessary blood evidence that the penalty for sin has been paid. God intended the Jews to approach Him the way He had established from the beginning with Adam and Eve - through a blood sacrifice for the forgiveness of sin. The individual Jew was saved from his sins through*

faith in the blood of the innocent substitutionary sacrifice.

God had in mind that when the Jews heard the Ten Commandments, they would run as fast as they could to the temple, kill a lamb and offer its blood in their place as a substitute sin offering to a holy God (pages 153-154)."

These words are in direct opposition to that of Messiah when He tells the rich, young ruler to keep the Commandments in order to have eternal life (Matthew 19:16-17).

With that said, my favorite part of this book is Chapter 16 on how to recognize the Jewish Messiah. The gospels were recorded specifically to show how Yeshua fulfilled all the Old Testament prophecies. If you have never studied the Messianic prophecies in detail, this is an excellent place to start. By tying the New to the Old Testament in the most beautiful way, we can get the full picture of how Jehovah chose to unite Israel - both Jew and Gentile as one group of believers with Christ as our teacher. Put your th**INK**ing cap on for this Messianic book and enjoy the challenge!

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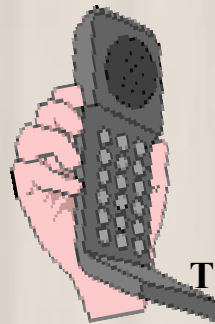


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LOOKING for Your Submissions for The Last in the Series...
