PENTECOST 06/12/2016
(FIRST DAY)

COUNT - SIT - WAIT

We are told prophetically by some red words to count to the day, sit and wait, "And, behold, I send the promise of my Father upon you: but tarry ye in the city of Jerusalem, until ye be endued with power from on high." (Luke 24:49) The word "tarry" is the Greek word "kathizo" carrying the idea to fix, appoint or set. It is used as "sit" and is translated in KJV as "tarry." We are told to count this day - forever! It's a rehearsal...but, for what?

Just as the first Exodus will be eclipsed by the second one, Pentecost will be eclipsed by fulfillment in the millennial reign of Messiah. See...if the first Shavuot was a word from Jehovah and the fulfillment of that Shavuot was the Pentecost recorded in the New Testament book of Acts that resulted in the Word of God being within us...then, what awaits those who **COUNT TO THAT ETERNAL PENTECOST IN THE NEW MILLENNIUM?**

Joshua 4:1-19, "And it came to pass, when all the people were clean passed over Jordan, that the LORD spake unto Joshua, saying, Take you twelve men out of the people, out of every tribe a man, And command ye them, saying, Take you hence out of the midst of Jordan, out of the place where the priests' feet stood firm, twelve stones, and ye shall carry them over with you, and leave them in the lodging place, where ye shall lodge this night. Then Joshua called the twelve men, whom he had prepared of the children of Israel, out of every tribe a man: And Joshua said unto them, Pass over before the ark of the LORD your God into the midst of Jordan, and take ye up every man of you a stone upon his shoulder, according unto the number of the tribes of the children of Israel: That this may be a sign

among you, that when your children ask their fathers in time to come...

For the priests which bare the ark stood in the midst of Jordan, until every thing was finished that the LORD commanded Joshua to speak unto the people, according to all that Moses commanded Joshua: and the people hasted and passed over. And it came to pass, when all the people were clean passed over, that the ark of the LORD passed over, and the priests, in the presence of the people...

On that day the LORD magnified Joshua in the sight of all Israel; and they feared him, as they feared Moses, all the days of his life... And it came to pass, when the priests that bare the ark of the covenant of the LORD were come up out of the midst of Jordan, and the soles of the priests' feet were lifted up unto the dry land, that the waters of Jordan returned unto their place, and flowed over all his banks, as they did before. And the people came up out of Jordan on the tenth day of the first month, and encamped in Gilgal, in the east border of Jericho."

So, when did all these things happen? We have to read some more... Joshua 5:10-11, "And the children of Israel encamped in Gilgal, and kept the passover on the fourteenth day of the month at even in the plains of Jericho. And they did eat of the old corn of the land on the morrow after the passover, unleavened cakes, and parched corn in the selfsame day." Joshua 8:30-31, "Then Joshua built an altar unto the LORD God of Israel ...an altar of whole stones, over which no man hath lift up any iron: and they offered thereon burnt offerings unto the LORD, and sacrificed peace offerings."

Notice what happened... Joshua 8:32-35, "And he wrote there upon the stones a copy of the law of Moses, which he wrote in the presence of the children of Israel. ... And afterward he read all the words of the law, the blessings and cursings, according to all that is written in the book of the law. There was not a word of all that Moses commanded, which Joshua read not before all the congregation of Israel, with the women, and the little ones, and the strangers that were conversant among them."

What was going on? Look for the next RLE-zine when we will add more to the history of this event, and hopefully the gestalt will explode in you to make this Pentecost the best ever! In the meantime... **KEEP COUNTING!**

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Hello again, hope all is well with you. Happy Passover! I've been listening nearly every day and still don't know whether you kept the Holy Days last month or if you're looking forward to it on the 21st of April, as we are. I heard from a friend that he got word from a friend of his in Israel that the barley was Abib at the last crescent. There are as many opinions about that as there are people I've talked to about it, with more to come, I'm sure. I also understand that God provided a "second" Passover for those who are unable to keep the true one for whatever reason, or are not in the Holy Land. We kind of think we may be keeping the "second" one, very grateful He made such a

provision for us as we realize more and more how important these days are. We enjoy your program very much and your words prompt a lot of discussion between my wife, family, friends and me (discussion about the only true Word of God).

Things you reveal in your show cause a lot of other things to fall into place in my mind, as I think about and discuss them. Things I'm not even thinking about, as I yield to Him, become clearer than ever before. It's slow going for me because I'm so stubborn and slow sometimes but it's going, that's the important thing isn't it? Even some of the things I think of as "fringe" reading seem to link themselves up, like the director just shouted "places!" I don't know if we're in the very last days or not but things certainly seem to be moving toward something history-making.

Keep on doing what you do, we're seeing changes in both our girls, who ... both have disdain for Christianity because our example stunk. But something must be different in their estimation because the oldest, who is steeped in the 1st-day apostasy is starting to really understand the Sabbath and Holy Days and our youngest, who has landed more on the side of the far Eastern side of religion (not a devotee by any standard) she seems to actually HEAR me when I talk to her about religion and spirituality now. I try not to preach anymore but to just talk to them, not that I really preached before but I was all about dogma.

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I am delighted that you have written to me. The TRI website was on my long list of sites I want to check carefully. Then my friend told me how influential you are in his life, and I was compelled to go immediately to your site. I knew I should ask for your free book, Think Red Ink, and I received that surprisingly quickly. Reading that was so impactful that it would take many pages to relate.

I attempted without success to order another item from you, so turned to Amazon and now have your three books available there - The Red Letter Questions, The Questions of Jesus, and On Manna. I am reading On Manna now. When I say "reading," I want to explain that this is very unlike when I read a science article, for example. It is much more a multi-dimensional life review in the presence of what I call the still small voice. I have also been listening to your online dvds and audio teachings.

The first thing to rivet my attention in reading Think Red Ink was that we both have a life beginning in the Assembly of God denomination. Our life paths were very different, but we were confronted with the same types of teachings and assumptions. Even as a very young child, I found discrepancies and contradictions between what was taught/preached and what I read in the Bible and especially what was the witness in my spirit of truth.

Circumstances were such that by the time I was a young adolescent, I knew I was Jewish. My deepest desire was to love, serve, and follow in all possible ways everything Jesus, my Messiah, taught us to do. I am now 67 years old. The path has not been easy, but I never chose to step away from Him, and despite my sometimes pathetic responses to challenges,

He has never left me.

I have lived many years in various places in the world. I was immersed in the heart of the Jesus seminar people as a university professor. I had a year studying Talmud with a group of orthodox men (permitted as long as I kept my mouth shut). Sometimes I was in third world places and did not have a Bible for a long time. My commitment to Jesus, to Yeshua, goes far beyond what I call just belief or commitment. It is a living, dynamic, breath by breath relationship.

As I have sought guidance through my life, I can now look back and see a pattern. I will be urged to explore and learn in a particular direction, sometimes for months, sometimes for years. When I am beginning to wonder how all this fits with all the other seemingly unrelated trajectories I have been led to go down, then I will have a strong urge to check out another topic, or maybe a name. And there I will find another person or small group of people, also followers of Yeshua, who have explored in the same direction and have come to very similar conclusions as have I. I will be overjoyed with this confirmation.

Finding your teachings and ministry seems to be part of the beginning of another time of confirmation, as I am finding, without looking for them, more and more testimonies of others who have arisen out of church backgrounds to come to the knowledge that we are to follow the commands and teachings of Yeshua and His Torah, without the takanot or ma'asim of the rabbis and without the pagan accretions which permeate Christianity. While I am in agreement with what I have read and heard so far of your teachings, they are being used to change me in right ways. I become aware of new little places for examination and repentance within myself.

I find refinements which bolster and strengthen my heartmind. I find new ways of expression and explanation which I know will arise within me again at appropriate times when I am talking with others. Thank you for choosing to be His servant. Thank you too for choosing to maintain your connections with the Assembly of God.

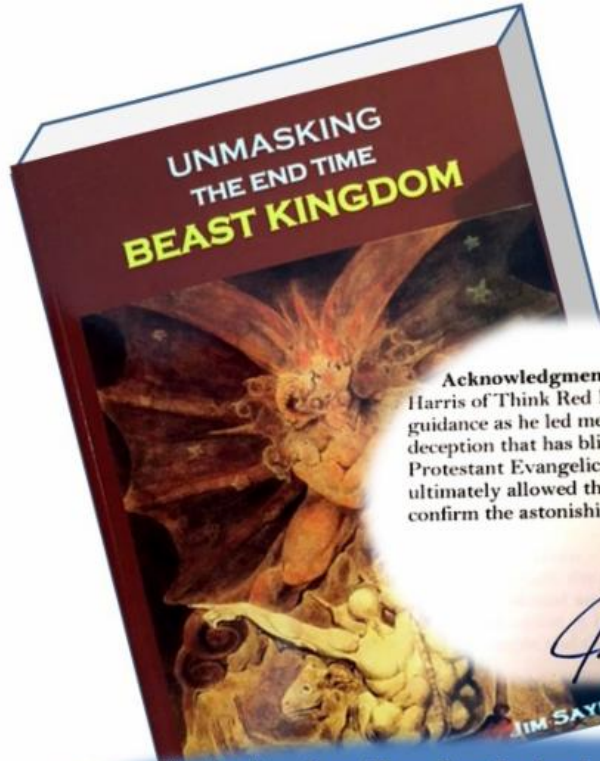
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Never heard anything like this before! Today's 1 1/2 hrs should be on disc titled "I love to tell the story." It was a complete story with no nonsense at anytime.
