It may be that their new lease on life had indeed restored to them what they had lost. But it did not seem to give them the one characteristic that the One who had healed them so longed to see...


GRATITUDE.

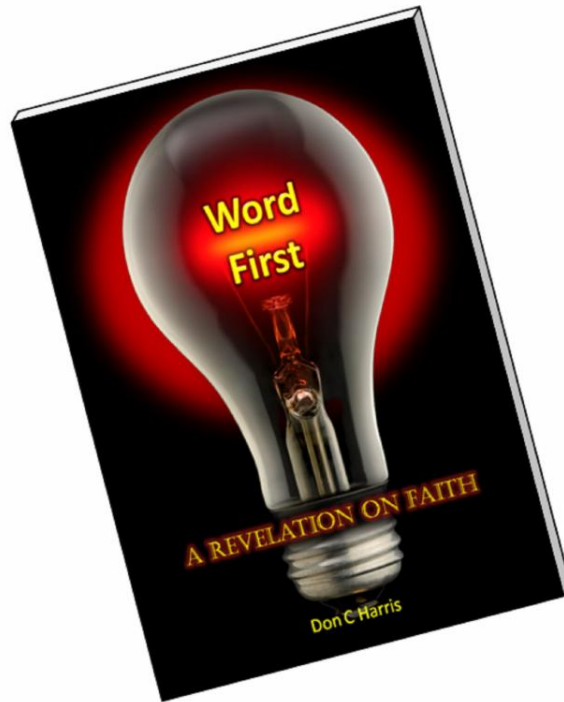

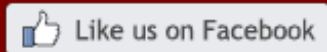
