## *Jesus came to teach us - to think!*

My convictions and the commitment of Think Red Ink Ministries to do things "Jesus' way" is often the opposite of conventional wisdom. Personally, I sometimes struggle with the enormous task of prying desperate hands 'off-the-Bible' so people have the opportunity to hear the Word of God. The very nature of what I'm suggesting seems to push people away.

I am in no way suggesting the testimonies and stories of the Bible are without merit; I would that our lives mimic those Exemplars. I simply can see no way to accomplish that goal without the guidance of the Holy Spirit; nor a way to receive guidance without obedience to the Word of God, Jesus, who said, *"Keep my commandments."*

When one door closes...

Many were disappointed that the finances did not come in to renew the KAZQ Channel 32 contract last year. Feedback was positive from many in the Albuquerque area; however, the interest did not translate into support required to continue the broadcast. Think Red Ink does not operate on borrowed money, nor do we engage in contracts that cannot be paid in full. In short, there were more people interested in the broadcast from outside the ministry than there were inside the ministry. Think Red Ink would never ask those outside who receive from the ministry to finance this work. Financing the work was our duty, as disciples.

Also, as many of you know my health, specifically the blindness I incurred last year, severely limits my ability to accomplish what I would be able to do "sighted" with ease. This is frustrating and leads to continual re-evaluation of what can be accomplished. It is difficult to have such an answer as *"think red ink"* and diminished personal capacity. Hiring work done is not an option, skilled volunteers are rare, and I simply am repeatedly forced to *"do less."* I refuse to accept the assessment that, *"If God wants a ministry to prosper it will."* - That philosophy was not true for John the Baptist, Jesus Christ or the Apostles. Nor am I willing to believe that the achievement of financial gain equals God's approval.

We, the people, have power and a role to play. Jesus gave us (the thinkers, the hearers) the key... there is a price to pay - many times it simply comes down to acceptance. Jesus said, *"...if they persecuted me... [they will persecute you] ...the servant is not greater than his master..."*

The absence of live shows on Red Letter Edition for a time is a necessity. Remember, in the Broadcast world, the opposite of "LIVE" is "RECORDED", not "DEAD". *"It's not like you think..."*

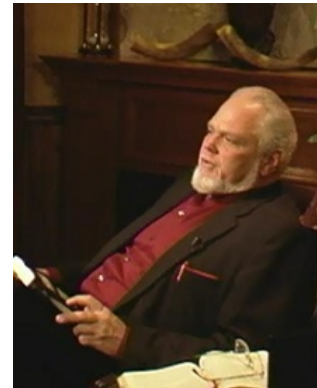

Another door opens...

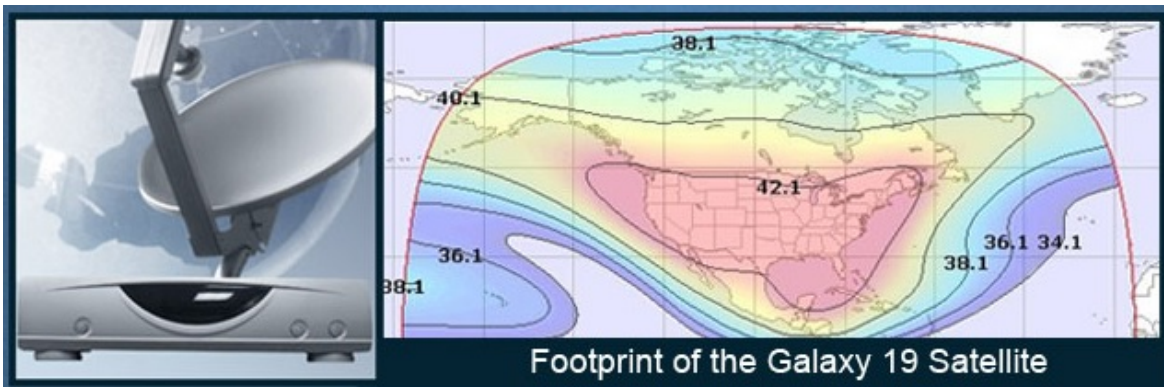

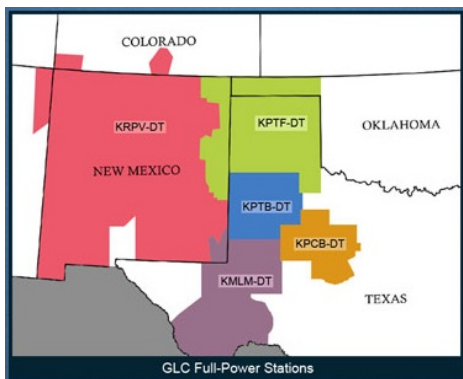
