

Have you ever considered what a great Teacher and Guide you have in the Lord Jesus?

One of the most difficult tasks of a teacher is the proper and honest evaluation of his students.

- Where is your student academically?
- What is his level of understanding?
- What are his achievements?
- What academic foundations will you build upon as you begin to teach him?
- What gaps does your student have in his prior education?

If these things are unknown, there is a risk of taking the student into areas hecannot comprehend - no matter what you teach - or how well you may teach it.

"...for he knew what was in man." John 2:25

The responsibility of teaching is huge and because of theological gaps, improper Biblical foundations, twisted motivations, lives lived in constant violation of conscience, and character flaws in each individual student casualties are devastating. Many have taken the knowledge that has been "pressed" into their ears and rather than setting them free, it has caused "shipwreck" and ruin in their lives:

Paul's instruction to Timothy: "This charge I commit unto thee, son Timothy, according to the prophecies which went before on thee, that thou by them mightest war a good warfare; Holding faith, and a good conscience; which some having put away concerning faith have made shipwreck:" (I Tim. 1:18-19)

False doctrine, heady and high-minded persons of little charity, proud and pretentious lifestyles, utter foolish and selfish teaching - all come from the *TRUTH* handed to those who did not possess the character to hold the truth in righteousness.

Romans 1:17-21, "For therein is the righteousness of God revealed from faith to faith: as it is written, The just shall live by faith. For the wrath of God is revealed from heaven against all ungodliness and unrighteousness of men, who hold the truth in unrighteousness; Because that which may be known of God is manifest in them; for God hath shewed it unto them. For the invisible things of him from the creation of the world are clearly seen, being understood by the things that are made, even his eternal power and Godhead; so that they are without excuse: Because that, when they knew God, they glorified him not as God, neither were thankful; but became vain in their imaginations, and their foolish heart was darkened."

You see, the LORD YHVH can devastate a soul not ready to receive the slightest instruction.

- **1. Carnality:** 1 Corinthians 3:2-4, "... And I, brethren, could not speak unto you as unto spiritual, but as unto carnal, *even* as unto babes in Christ. I have fed you with milk, and not with meat: for hitherto ye were not able *to bear it*, neither yet now are ye able. For ye are yet carnal: for whereas*there is* among you envying, and strife, and divisions, are ye not carnal, and walk as men? For while one saith, I am of Paul; and another, I *am* of Apollos; are ye not carnal? Who then is Paul, and who *is* Apollos, but ministers by whom ye believed, even as the Lord gave to every man?"
- **2.** Lack of good conscience: I Tim. 1:18-19, "...Holding; which some having put away (faith, and a good conscience" have made shipwreck:"
- **3. Unrighteous motivations:** Romans 1:17-21, "For therein is the righteousness of God revealed "... men, who hold the truth in unrighteousness; Because that which may be known of God is manifest in them; for God hath shewed it unto them. For the invisible things of him ... are clearly seen, [and] understood ..."
- **4. It is not time:** John 16:12-15, "I have yet many things to say unto you, but ye cannot bear them now"

We must be ready, righteous and responsible to receive a word from YHVH to help us. Otherwise, we will be (according to the Scriptures we read above) Ignorant, proud, teachers of things we don't know.

The Apostle Paul was no kinder in I Timothy 1:5-7: "Now the end of [obedience] is charity out of a pure heart, and a good conscience, and faith unfeigned: From which some, having swerved, have turned aside unto vain jangling; Desiring to be teachers ... understanding neither what they say, nor whereof they affirm."

Wow! Seems there are a lot of ways to get this wrong. But, not if we love, not if we live in humility, not if obey our conscience, not if we erase the chalkboards the class trouble makers have written on, and we are in our desks, ready when the bell rings.

It is, after our "Father's pleasure to give us the kingdom."
