Hey, Don...

NM KAZQ THINKER: Teacher, preacher, minister, what? I've only been watching [Words of Jesus - KAZQ 32] a few months. I haven't decided, I sometimes think you're 100% right and others 50% right. I'm not saying any percent wrong. New teaching for me, shocking but mostly acceptable. I'm looking for knowledge and covenant with my Father and Lord more than in my head. I'm 74 years old and have been a believer (IN BIBLE) since a child. I DO NOT have a relationship it's ALL head knowledge. God Bless and keep you teaching for lost ones like me.

REPLY FROM DON: Good news, you are not lost. You are called; you just find it difficult to answer the call. If you grew up in conventional Christianity, you were probably given the "common drill" - accept Jesus, ask forgiveness, then fill-in the list with denominational dos and don'ts. When Jesus was asked how to obtain eternal life he said, "Keep my commandments." These are the commandments written by Him on Mt. Sinai, the ten of which we are well aware. Doing this makes us safe, but I have a feeling you are looking for regeneration. Regeneration is the grace that Jesus brought, "the power to become a child of God".

Regeneration occurs as a person follows Jesus advice, consider your own desires less important, be willing to die for what you believe and make your life resemble His. It was His promise that if we keep his commandments, He and His Father will move into us as the guiding Spirit of our lives. You have probably heard me say and will continue to hear me say, "I only have three bits of advice for people who want a relationship with God, 1) Keep the Commandments; 2) Never disobey your conscience; and 3) take time everyday to hear the Voice of God." Don't look for any instantaneous happenings in your life, visions, lightning flashes, etc. It will more than likely occur to you over a time of obedience, that God has been a part of your life from the day you made the decision to go His way and not yours.

An additional note, I am convinced that there are millions of people just like yourself, but what makes you peculiar is that you are well aware of

your condition. For me, that is proof that it is God's intention to have you in His kingdom. Look forward to meeting you, here, there, anywhere.

NM KAZQ THINKER: I have been listening to your program for a couple of months, off and on at first, because it seemed to me that you did not really "know" Jesus as I do. After listening awhile longer, it may be that the true message of your kinship to the Lord may be less apparent some days due to frustration with some of the "stuff" that has been spoon-fed us during our lifetimes. I am 85 and during those very busy times of working, raising families and being happy to just make it through another day, the most time we could allot to our Lord was Sun. morning and evening, Wed. night and the service we did at our churches in our other free times. However, the past few years have brought about an opportunity to listen to others besides our pastors.

As you have stated, we are told a lot of things that many repeat as true, but I question those as to where it is found in the Scriptures. Some things, like the celebration of the Mass for Christ was first suggested to me by my son as not Biblical. And, I have heard you mention that people (or something like this) worship the Bible. I treasure it, because it is a comfort to read and know the actual history of man and have the confidence that the Bible tells me that men wrote it under the inspiration of the Holy Spirit. It is certainly more worthwhile to spend my time reading that than, say, the Drudge Report." But, unfortunately, when my son first suggested we as a family rethink continuing the, probable, wrong date to assign as a birth date for Jesus with all of the idiotic frivolities that take place, we did not agree. We all thought that the only ones who held that view were Jehovah's Witnesses with whom we all disagreed regarding the message they presented and the way it was done. Now, however, the idea of nailing a cut tree to a base and decorating it with questionable stuff, and, as it appears to have taken on a form of worship in our culture, I happily say, "no more." And, Easter as well. But all the churches in this area, to my knowledge, find no problem with the celebrations or the excess of same.

I am a misfit. Attending a corporate service on Sun. has gone by the wayside for the past 4-5 years. There are still a handful of ministries who appear to be true believers who are not hawking their wares rather than the gospel. These are getting mighty few. ...Keep encouraging your listeners in the way God instructs you to do so. Some of us are listening, and we also listen to our Shepherd because we know his voice and he knows us.

REPLY FROM DON: It is encouraging to hear from KAZQ listeners. As you note, my journey through Christianity has led me through quite a bit of "stuff" as you call it. – I almost gave up, then decided to give the Bible 'another read.' I believe the Christianity involved in raising children and making it through life IS the important work we have to do. Jesus did not mention the time we spent in study, but He was and is extremely interested in how we care for one another. As you note, the Scriptures are an invaluable tool to our generation – we just don't seem to read them. Thank you for writing and for listening to The Shepherd. I'm encouraged to hear that you've accepted into your life uncomfortable changes – this is almost never done. But, you should be prepared because when the Lord finds someone who listens to him and acts upon what he says – he reveals more. Oh, yes, so much more. My mother, also 85, is surprised how far her Christianity has moved from what she first believed. Keep listening and "Think Red Ink."
