On Truth (Conclusion)



The Bible is a trustworthy book.

Isaiah 46:10 "Declaring the end from the beginning, and from ancient times the things that are not yet done, saying, My counsel shall stand, and I will do all my pleasure."

I got my answer; I held out for Truth and it came. I accepted it. I have since found no reason to doubt what I found nor has Scripture shown it to be false. I believe it is so and own it as teachable doctrine.

Problem:

If we are to seek, find and hold Truth if we are to truly love the Truth and hold it in righteousness, what are we expected to do when we encounter false doctrine? What are we going to do with Palm Sunday? Good Friday? Easter? Where did they originate if they have no roots in the Scriptures?

Paim Sunday is based on an erroneous calculation of Easter. If Christ died on Friday, the calculation works. It goes like this, John's gospel places the date of His Bethany visitation at six days before Passover. The next day He rode into Jerusalem. They assume Passover was on Friday, six days before that would be Saturday, the next day would be Sunday. Now that we know that Passover that year was on Thursday, one day earlier than thought, we now know it actually was (John 12) [1] Sabbath that Jesus rode into Jerusalem. This doctrine's roots are in Catholicism, and is based on incorrect assumptions and for the expressed purpose of Sunday celebrations. So much for Palm Sunday.

Good Friday was just a calculation based on the confusion of weekly Sabbath and a High Sabbath day. They assumed the Sabbath mentioned as the next day, was a Saturday, and therefore deduced He died on Friday. We found that not to be the case at all. Again, rooted in Catholicism and error.

Easter is another matter altogether. If our Lord was in the grave for exactly three day and nights as He said, He did not rise on Sunday morning at all. He rose on Sabbath evening just before dark, as he was buried just before dark on Wednesday evening. Remember the angel told Mary early [2] (John 20) that First Day morning, "He is not here." Why do Christians feel justified in standing outside and waiting for the sun to rise on Easter? He did not rise at sunrise at all, as a matter of fact, this old custom predated Christ [3] (Ezekiel 8). We must search out these rituals so that we are not an offense to God. We cannot ignore Biblical facts and expect His blessings.

One will find the "facts" of the resurrection hard to discern from the Gospel accounts, but one thing is for sure, the way it is celebrated now is error. Even the fact that it is celebrated at all is dubious as were never told to do so. The actions, based in paganism, neither mandated nor suggested is the antithesis of the life led by the Truth that will make us free.

Here are the questions I asked myself.

- Where did this rising on Sunday come?
- Should we celebrate it?
- What does Truth dictate that we should do?
- Am I really dedicated to Truth?
- Is my dedication to Truth going to force me to give up long and dearly held traditions? [4]
- Should I put my hand to this turning plow that is headed down the field I planted and is just starting to bud?[5]

A brief tour of Church history will reveal to the seeker that Easter is rooted in worship of the Sun. An untrue story of a resurrection of Nimrod – a lie. Some may say that it is not that way today and so it is not to be shunned and avoided as pagan. And that, in spirit, we worship God and that makes it all right. I would be willing to agree if the Lord said we are to worship in spirit only. But, as you know He said, *"Ye worship ye know not what: we know what we worship: for salvation is of the Jews. But the hour cometh, and now is, when the true worshippers shall worship the Father in spirit and in truth: for the Father seeketh such to worship him. God is a Spirit: and they that worship him must worship him in spirit and in truth." John 4:22-24. Also in 1 John 2:21b, "... no lie is of the truth." John 8:44 (abridged), <i>"Ye are of your father the devil, and the lusts of your father ye will do. He ... abode not in the truth, because there is no truth in him. ... he is a liar, and the father of it."*

Easter is steeped in the worship of Ashtaroth the Goddess of the Zidonians. She was specifically a god of the Amorites that was on the other side of Jordan. Rooted in Babylonian culture, she has continued to this day, known as Istar, Ishtar, Ashtaroth, The Queen of heaven, Mother of God, and after her was Easter named.

Emperor Constantine worshipped the sun and after his "conversion to Christianity" he incorporated the two into one. Changing the day of rest from Sabbath to the Venerable Day of the Sun, (Sunday) and combining the Pasach and the resurrection of the Sun God to create Easter was two of his greatest accomplishments.

Conclusion:

The dedication to Truth has taken us down a path we may not have wanted to travel. Or perhaps you see opening before you the way for which you have longed to worship God in the freedom and freshness of Truth. Why do we insist on celebration invented by us and reject the feast days that He provided[6]? The story in the Bible of Jeroboam is a prime example of worship of the true God in an untrue manner. Worship devised and directed of man is never good, nor is it Truth.

1 Kings 12:32-33, "And Jeroboam ordained a feast in the eighth month, on the fifteenth day of the month, like unto the feast that is in Judah, ... and he placed in Bethel the priests of the high places which he had made. So he offered upon the altar which he had made in Bethel the fifteenth day of the eighth month, even in the month which he had devised of his own heart; and ordained a feast unto the children of Israel..."

The right day, the right God (although graven images were used), the right sacrifices, but, JEROBOAM chose the month.

Funny thing about Truth. It's all or nothing.

As David so painfully learned in Perez Uzzah [7], you do God's work God's way.

How can we say to God, "I worship you, my way."?

"Woe unto them! for they have gone in the way of Cain," Jude 1:11

What is the way of Cain if it is not worshiping God Your way?

We must be honest and say that not only have we forsaken His holy days, we have replaced them with our holidays.

"Now therefore fear the LORD, and serve him in sincerity and in truth: and put away the gods which your fathers served on the other side of the flood, and in Egypt; and serve ye the LORD. And if it seem evil unto you to serve the LORD, choose you this day whom ye will serve; whether the gods which your fathers served that were on the other side of the flood, or the gods of the Amorites, in whose land ye dwell: but as for me and my house, we will serve the LORD."
